Who can be a cadet?

Year 11 or 12, studying Certificate II in Forest Growing & Management

As a Forico cadet, you'll be in Year 11 or 12 and studying a Certificate II in Forest Growing & Management.

You will spend one day per week in paid employment with Forico, based at our Ridgley office and gaining work experience in our forests: learning about the sustainable management of plantations, and how we manage the natural environment in and around them for our native plants and animals.

You will need a driver's license or means of transport to our Ridgley office.
